Salawaat of Sadaqah The equivalent of a great Sadaqah

الله رَّصِلِ عَلَى مُحَمَّدٍ عَبْدِكَ وَمَسُولِكَ وَصَلِّ عَلَى اللهُمَّ مِنْ الْمُولِكَ وَصَلِّ عَلَى اللهُمَّ اللهُمُّ مِنْ مَا اللهُ عُمِنِيْنَ وَالْمُسْلِمِيْنَ وَالْمُسْلِمِيْنَ وَالْمُسْلِمَاتِ

Allahumma salli 'alaa Muhammadin 'abdika wa rasulika wa salli 'alal mu'mineena wal mu'minaat wal muslimeena wal muslimaat

Oh Allah! Send Your blessings upon Muhammad who is Your servant and messenger. And send Your blessing upon the believing men and the believing women, and the Muslim men and the Muslim women.

Value of reciting this salawaat

It is mentioned in ahadith that by giving sadaqah one can reconcile with Allah so that He is no longer angry with you.

Abu Saeed al-Khudri related that the Messenger of Allah said: That if a Muslim does not have the means to give sadaqah then one should incorporate this salawaat in their dua so that Allah said: will grant them the reward of giving sadaqah.

Abu Humaira also narrated that the Holy Prophet advised him to recite this salawaat as it is for you a sadqah. Hence we should include this salawaat in our daily devotional practices.
